This program supports parents, grandparents and caregivers with children aged 3, 4, and 5, to best support their child's pre-literacy and school-readiness. Parents meet weekly for 12 weeks with a community facilitator who is trained in how to best mentor and coach parents. Parents learn how to best connect with their children, nurturing parent-child attachment and making it easier for them to do fun pre-literacy activities together at home.

There will be 12 group meetings for parents to join the multicultural program. Parents and children get to enjoy lunch together and connect with other parents.
